DIRECTIONS

1. Remove loose or excess residue.
2. Apply full strength to the adhesive. Avoid over-application.
3. Agitate into area with any hand held implements like Gum Getter™ or bone scraper. Poke into the contaminant surface to allow the Citrus Gel to penetrate.
4. Allow to dwell for 3-5 minutes.
5. Blot or scrape up excess along with any adhesive that has been loosened. Repeat steps 2-5 if necessary.
6. Blot and rinse the area thoroughly, with Empowered Water™.

7. Mist Finishing Spray on treated areas. Brush Finishing Spray to both align the fibers and evenly distribute the product.
